In a new demonstration of the quality of Chilean wines, Viña Errázuriz's two icon wines, Don Maximiano Founder's Reserve and Señá, both from the 2005 vintage, took first and second place respectively in the traditional "The Berlin Tasting," held recently in Stockholm. The wines were chosen by an important group of Swedish consumers over the finest French and Italian wines.

This blind tasting reaffirmed the world-class natures of Chilean wine with respect to French Bordeaux icons, such as Château Latour and Mouton, or Italian wines from Tuscany such as Ornellaia and Sassicaia.

In commenting on the results, Eduardo Chadwick affirmed that they had once again met the objective of showing "the high quality of our icon wines, which are on a par with the best Cabernet

Sauvignons in the world. This result is a testimony to our passion for producing the best wines and the recognition is well-deserved."

The results of the Stockholm tasting mirrored those of the 2008 The Beijing Tasting, in which the 2005 Don Maximiano Founder's Reserve was awarded first place followed by the 2005 Señá, which sends a clear message of excellence and quality in markets as diverse as those of Asia and Europe.

The now-traditional The Berlin Tasting began in 2004 and revolutionized the wine world when the Chilean icons Viñedo Chadwick 2000 and Señá 2001 took the top two positions over the French wines Château Margaux, Lafite, and Latour, as well as the Italian Sassicaia and Tignanello.
